Accidental Damage Protection Plans

Sonic Device Repair is proposing accidental damage protection plans coverage for new devices enrolled within 30 days of purchase.

The accidental damage warranty is separate from the manufacturer's warranty and can be enrolled during the original warranty period.

Accidental damage protection coverage begins on the date of enrollment. Expiration is determined by a negotiated contract term.

Devices can be re-enrolled in accidental damage plans when the chosen term is complete.

What is covered?

SDR Accidental Damage Protection Plans cover "accidental damage" including, but not limited to:

- Motherboard Repair
- Cracked Screens
- Bezels/frames/housing
- Keyboard Damage
- Drops
- Liquid Exposure/submersion
- Software Support
- Operating System Failure
- Hard Drive Failure
- Component Mechanical Failure
- Webcams, disc drives, microphones
- Power Failure

Battery replacement and repair is not covered under protection plans

What do I owe?

After initial warranty dues are paid there is no deductible or fees unless repairs are outside of accidental damage protection coverage. SDR will use best discretion in these instances and will work with you for these types of repairs.
